Being Bold – On the Move
Acts 20:1-16
Taught on January 6, 2019

Everyone knows people who are driven by something. As a group, list three positive and three negative things that people may be driven by.

Now, discuss the logical conclusion of each “driver” if a person lived that way for the rest of their life. (i.e. If they were driven by fear, they would never experience their fullest potential or enjoy all that life has to offer.)

Read Philippians 3:7-8

- Why does Paul consider *this* to be of highest importance to him?
- How does this compare to other things that drive people—like the six you came up with earlier?

Read Philippians 3:12-14

- What does it mean to be “forgetting what lies behind?” How does a person do this?
- Do you think it is possible to live out vv. 12-14 today? Why or why not?
- What do you think it would look like to live out vv. 12-14?

How do you intend to orient your life to be driven by your relationship with Jesus?
