Being Bold – Trusting God
Acts 21:1-16
Taught on January 27, 2019

If you had an “Easy Button,” what would you use it for?

What have you had to do in life that was hard?

The Apostle Paul has been pushing to get back to Jerusalem. Twice during his journey he received prophecies of what was to come in Jerusalem. (Read vv. 3-6, 10-12) But Paul knew God wanted him to continue to Jerusalem (see 20:22). Why do you think God provided these warnings for Paul?

(Leader’s note: we don’t know why, but it could be to prepare Paul for what was ahead and so that Paul could be a living example of making hard choices for Jesus)

Read Paul’s response to the peoples’ pleading that he not go in vs. 13.

Describe that scene in your own words.

How do you think Paul felt as they were pleading with him?

What do you learn from Paul about doing hard things for Jesus?

Read Luke 2:42 and then Acts 21:14.

What do you learn here about submitting to God?

What do you learn about trusting God?

How does this impact your life today?
