Being Bold – Preparing Your Defense
Acts 21:17-22:29
Taught on February 17, 2019

Why do you think some Christians are hesitant to talk about Jesus?

What would make a difference in becoming bolder about one's faith?

Read Acts 22:3-6. Paul describes his life before becoming a follower of Jesus. Based on his "before" description, how would you describe your life "before" Jesus? (If you became a Christian as a child, what *would* your life have been like if you *hadn't* accepted Christ?)

Read Acts 22:6-16. Paul has a very unique story of how he met Jesus. How did you become a Christian? What realization did you come to in order to place your faith in Christ?

Read Acts 22:17-21. Paul describes how his life changed from pursuing Christians to making Christ-followers. How has your life changed as a result of becoming a Christ follower?

Before you meet again, take time to write out your story so that it can be read/said in 2 minutes or less (you can always expand it if people want to hear more). Read your stories to each other when you come back together as a group. Look for opportunities to share your story with someone else in the coming week!
