Being Bold – Staying Focused  
Based on Acts 28  
Taught on April 14, 2019

Are you a multi-tasker or a single-focused individual? How do you handle distractions?

In your lifetime, what are some things you have done consistently well?

What has contributed to your consistency?

Throughout Paul's ministry in Acts he has one primary calling: preach first to the Jews, then to the Gentiles. Read Acts 28:17-24

What are the actions Paul takes to stay consistent in his calling?  
(Proactive with the Jews, called them "Brothers" to establish connection, presented the truth of why he was in chains, declared Jesus from the Law and Prophets, etc.)

Not everyone believed, so how was he successful? (he was successful in staying true to his mission; he wasn't responsible for who did/didn't accept Christ)

Paul quotes the same passage from Isaiah (6:9-10) that Jesus quoted about the Jews (Matthew 13:14-15). Read Acts 28:25-27

Upon whom does God place the responsibility for people who do not believe?

How did the Jews' response affect the consistency of Paul's calling?

If you were to describe the universal calling of God on each Christ-follower, what would you include?

How can we grow in consistency in our calling?
